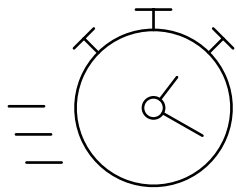

ECO BY THE NUMBERS

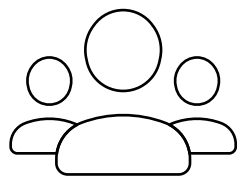

Waitlist to enroll. Wait times vary based on attorney & clinic capacity.

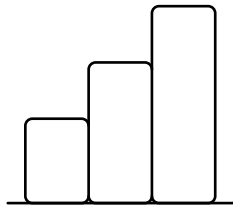
APPROVED

To be eligible, must be Oregonian & under 200% poverty guidelines.

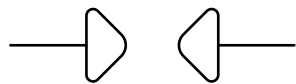
ENROLLED

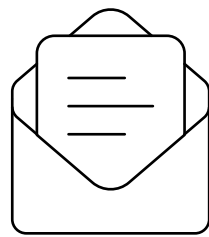


FIGHTING AGAINST DETENTION

In October, ECO enrolled 230+ detained individuals into the program as part of a rapid response effort to combat ICE unlawfulness against Oregonians, up from just under 100 in the first six months of 2025.

ECO's Call Center provides a common touch point for ECO members to request information and inform ECO about updates to their case..

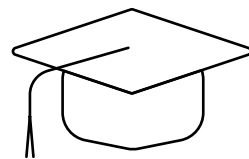

Detained Demographics

The majority of detained Oregonians are men, and they range from as young as 15 to as old as 70. ECO refers these individuals to attorneys to help them request bond and fight for their release.
